To participate in commencement exercises or receive a Stapleton Public Schools diploma a student must fully complete all requirements for graduation prior to the official commencement exercises, and complete other administrative requirements or conditions. Students who graduate from Stapleton Public Schools must accumulate 240 hours. The total graduation requirements must include the following core curriculum:

<b>Social Studies</b> (Geography, World History, American History, American Government, or Economics)	<b>40</b>	<b>Semester Hours</b>
<b>Physical Education</b> (PE/Health I or PE/Health II)	<b>10</b>	<b>Semester Hours</b>
<b>Practical Arts/Vocational</b> (Business, Industrial Technology or Foreign Language)	<b>40</b>	<b>Semester Hours</b>
<b>Fine Arts</b> (Art or Music)	<b>20</b>	<b>Semester Hours</b>
<b>Electives</b>	<b>30</b>	<b>Semester Hours</b>
